Thomas Lyle Tyler, 68, of Bath passed away at 2:05 a.m. at his home on Monday, February 18, 2019. He was born on March 24, 1950 in Canton to Willis Loyal and Donna Jean Irene (Snyder) Tyler. He married Irene Padua on January 22, 1974.
