



## Vera Anita Krughoff

June 2, 1913 - May 26, 2013

Vera Anita Krughoff, formerly of San Jose, passed away on Sunday, May 26, 2013 at The Mason City Area Nursing Home in Mason City, Illinois at the age of 99.

She was a beloved daughter, sister, wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, aunt, friend and educator.

Vera was born June 2, 1913 at her parent's home near Manito, IL., the daughter of Ray V. and Myrtle Eidman Talbott. She married Melvin Classen on May 1, 1937. She later married Clarence Krughoff on March 20, 1976. He preceded her in death on May 18, 1983.

Vera graduated from Manito High School in 1930, attended Normal State College and received her bachelor of education degree in 1957 from Bradley University.
