Walter R. Imig, 98, of San Jose, IL died at Mason City Area Nursing Home at 8:00 am on Thursday, March 23, 2017. He was born November 5, 1918 to Jacob and Anna (Jacobs) Imig in rural San Jose. He married Hazel Moehring on November 25, 1945 at St. Luke Lutheran Church near San Jose.

Mr. Imig is survived by one son, Steven (Noreen) Imig of Palos Hills, IL and one daughter, Judith (Dennis) Rauch of San Jose; four grandchildren, Clinton (Angie) Rauch, Daren (Sarah) Rauch both of Clinton, IL, Jennifer (Dennis) Huffman of Heyworth, IL and Allison Imig of Fischer, IL; and nine great-grandchildren.
