January 30, 1919 - May 2, 2007

Walter N. "Sleepy" Miller, 88, of Petersburg, died Wednesday, May 2, 2007 at 4:00 am at Sunny Acres Home in Petersburg. He was born on January 30, 1919 in Menard County to Walter and Myrtle Norris Miller. He married Anna Mae Owens Batterton in 1959. She died in 1972. He later married Daisy W. Wells Minor on June 20, 1981 in Petersburg.
