Wayne Lyle Armbrust, 91, of Manito passed away August 5, 2015 at Pekin Manor. He was born in rural Topeka, Illinois on October 18, 1923, the oldest child of Arnold and Veneta Holste Armbrust. He married Annabelle Palmer on August 27, 1950 in Manito, Illinois. She survives. Also surviving are 3 children, Joyce (Dennis) Woodley of Spring, TX, Ronald (Lori) Armbrust of Manito, and Richard (Victoria) Armbrust of Green Valley. One sister, Wilma Hintz of Hopedale, also survives. He has 8 grandchildren-Ashley and Jeremy Woodley, Jason, Derrick, Adam and Abby Armbrust, Trish Rick, and Katie Coe. He loved spending time with his family and especially his 11 great grandchildren-Justin, Hayes, Rhys, Harmonie, and Eliza Woodley, Shayla, Brandon, Grant, and June Armbrust, Mallori Rick, and Wyatt Coe. Two brothers Carl Armbrust and Paul Armbrust preceded him in death.

Wayne was in the United States Army in World War II from 1945-1947. He was in Germany in the Army of Occupation during the war crimes trials. Wayne farmed in the Manito area most of his adult life, and he was a grain and livestock farmer.

He was a member of Community United Methodist Church, Hill-Palmer Post 561 of the American Legion, the Mason County Farm Bureau, and the Central Illinois Irrigated Growers as well as a former member of the Manito-Forest City Optimist Club and danced for 25 years in the Tri-County Twirlers Square
